#### D.C. LAW 11-156

"Excepted Service Positions Designation Temporary Amendment Act of 1996".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P.L. 93-198 "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill 11-685 on first and second readings, May 7, 1996 and June 4, 1996 respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on June 17, 1996, pursuant to Section 404(e) of "the Act", and was assigned Act 11-284 and published in the July 19, 1996 edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 43 page 3695) and transmitted to Congress on July 10, 1996 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 11-156, effective September 20, 1996.

## AN ACT D.C. ACT 11-284

Codification District of Columbia Code 1997 Supp.

### IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA JUNE 17, 1996

To amend, on a temporary basis, the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, to allocate up to an additional 40 Excepted Service positions subject to appointment by the Mayor to the Office of the Inspector General and, during a control year, up to an additional 20 Excepted Service positions to the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, and to repeal the requirement that lists of Excepted Service positions and incumbents in those positions be published in the *District of Columbia Register*.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Excepted Service Positions Designation Temporary Amendment Act of 1996".

Sec. 2. Section 903 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Code § 1-610.3), is amended as follows:

Note, Section 1-610.3

- (a) Subsection (a)(2) is amended by adding the following phrase after the word "District": ", except that up to an additional 40 positions subject to appointment by the Mayor shall be allocated to and designated by the Office of the Inspector General and, in a control year, up to an additional 20 positions subject to appointment by the Mayor shall be allocated to and designated by the Office of the Chief Financial Officer.".
  - (b) Subsection (c) is repealed.
- Sec. 3. The act will have no adverse fiscal impact. Agencies will continue to operate under the FTE ceilings and within budget constraints.
- Sec. 4. (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), approval by the Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Authority as provided in section 203(a) of the

District of Columbia Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Authority Act of 1995, approved April 17, 1995 (109 Stat. 116; D.C. Code § 47-392.3(a), and a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code § 1-233(c)(1), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.

(b) This act shall expire after the 225th day of its having taken effect or on the effective date of the Excepted Service Positions Designation Amendment Act of 1996,

whichever occurs first.
