"Kenneth H. Nash Post #8 American Legion Real Property Tax Exemption and Equitable Real Property Tax Relief Act of 1998"

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P.L. 93-198 "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 12- 412, on first and second readings, June 2, 1998 and June 16, 1998, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on July 8, 1998, pursuant to ection 404(e) of "the Act", and was assigned Act No. 12-411, and published in the August 7, 1998, edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 45 page 5185) and transmitted to Congress on July 29, 1998 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 12-168, effective October 16, 1998.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

JULY 8, 1998

To amend title 47 of the District of Columbia Code to exempt from taxation certain property of the American Legion in the District of Columbia to confer a tax exemption, and to provide equitable property tax relief to the Kenneth H. Nash Post #8 American Legion, from the expiration of the "Kenneth H. Nash Post # 8 American Legion Property Tax Exemption and Tax Relief Emergency Act of 1996," until the effective date of this act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Kenneth H. Nash Post #8 American Legion Real Property Tax Exemption and Equitable Real Property Tax Relief Act of 1998".

Sec. 2. Chapter 10 of Title 47 of the District of Columbia Code is amended as follows:

"§ 47-1035. The American Legion; lot 32 and 33 in square 185 and lot 01 in square 763.

- (a) The table of contents to the chapter is amended by striking the section designation "§ 47-1035. The American Legion; lot 32 and 33, square 185." and inserting the section designation "§ 47-1035. The American Legion; lot 32 and 33 in square 185 and lot 01 in square 763." in its place.
 - (b) Section 47-1035 is amended to read as follows:

Section 47-1035

- "The property situated in square 185 in the City of Washington, District of Columbia, described as lots 32 and 33, owned, occupied, and used by the American Legion, and the property situated in square 763 in the District of Columbia, described as lot 01, owned, occupied, and used by the Kenneth H. Nash Post #8 American Legion, are hereby exempt from all taxation so long as these same properties continue to be so owned and occupied, and not used for commercial purposes, subject to the provisions of § 47-1002, providing for exemptions of church and school properties."
- Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia orders that all real property taxes, interest, penalties, fees, and other related charges assessed against Kenneth H. Nash Post #8 American Legion, on real property located at 224 D Street, S.E., Washington, D.C., lot 01 in square 763, for tax years 1994 through tax year 1998 be forgiven, and that any payments made

for this period be refunded.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code § 1-233(c)(3)).

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), approval by the Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Authority as provided in section 203(a) of the District of Columbia Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Act of 1995, approved April 17, 1995 (109 Stat. 116; D.C. Code § 47-3392.3(a)), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code § 1-233(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
