To amend the EPA Miles Per Gallon Requirement for Passenger Automobiles Purchased by the District Act of 2000 to prohibit the District of Columbia government from purchasing sport utility vehicles for government use, except for security, emergency rescue, snow removal or armored vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Government Sport Utility Vehicle Purchasing Amendment Act of 2002".

Sec. 2. Section 3402 of the EPA Miles Per Gallon Requirement for Passenger Automobiles Purchased by the District Act of 2000, effective October 19, 2000 (D.C. Law 13-172; D.C. Official Code § 50-203), is amended as follows:

Amend § 50-203

- (a) The section heading is amended to read as follows: "EPA Miles Per Gallon requirement; restrictions on use of sport utility vehicles.".
 - (b) The existing text is designated as subsection (a).
- (c) The newly designated subsection (a) is amended by striking the period at end and inserting the phrase ", and shall not be a sports utility vehicle." in its place.
 - (d) A new subsection (b) is added to read as follows:
- "(b) The District of Columbia government shall not purchase sport utility vehicles for governmental use; provided, that this section shall not apply to security, emergency rescue, snow removal or armored vehicles.".

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602 (c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02 (c) (3)).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
