To amend, on an temporary basis, the Special Education Task Force Temporary Act of 2002, to add two parents of special education children to the composition of the Special Education Task Force.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Special Education Task Force Expansion Temporary Amendment Act of 2002".

Sec. 2. Section 5(b) of the Special Education Task Force Temporary Act of 2002, effective October 19, 2002 (D.C. Law 14-210; 49 DCR 7848), is amended as follows:

Sec. 4 Effective date.
