## IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend section 23-563 of the District of Columbia Official Code to provide that in cases of felony parental kidnapping a warrant or summons may be served anywhere within the United States, and to permit law enforcement authorities to extradite such offenders.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Parental Kidnapping Extradition Amendment Act of 2001".

Sec. 2. Section 23-563(a) of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by adding \$\frac{Amend}{\\$23-563}\$ the phrase "a felony under sections 16-1022 and 16-1024 or" after the phrase "summons for".

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), approval by the Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Authority as provided in section 203(a) of the District of Columbia Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Act of 1995, approved April 17, 1995 (109 Stat. 116; D.C. Official Code § 47-392.03(a)) (if received by September 30, 2001), a 60-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule
