Sec. 2. Section 3(d) of the District of Columbia Bus Shelter Act of 1979, effective May 10, 1980, (D.C. Law 3-67; D.C. Official Code § 9-1152(d)), is amended by striking the phrase "for a period of 10 years." and inserting the phrase "for a period of 20 years, to expire on December 31, 2025. After December 31, 2025, the term shall be 10 years." in its place.	Amend § 9-1152
Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.  The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).	
Sec. 4. Effective date.  This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
