IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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To amend the Anacostia Waterfront Corporation Act of 2004 to ensure that there is an appropriate number of members on the Corporation's Board of Directors by adding 2 new members to be filled by a recognized labor union organization and a recognized environmental organization.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Anacostia Waterfront Corporation Board Expansion Amendment Act of 2005".

Sec. 2. The Anacostia Waterfront Corporation Act of 2004, effective December 7, 2004 (D.C. Law 15-219; D.C. Official Code § 2-1223.01 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

(a) Section 105(a) is amended as follows:

(1) The lead-in text is amended to read as follows:

"The powers of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors which shall consist of the following 11 voting members, and may include 4 nonvoting members to be selected as follows:"

(2) Paragraph (1) is amended as follows:

(A) Subparagraph (A) is amended by striking the word "Seven" and inserting the word "Nine" in its place.

(B) New subparagraphs (E) and (F) are added to read as follows:

"(E) One public citizen member shall be a representative of a recognized labor union organization.

"(F) One public citizen member shall be a representative of a recognized environmental organization."

(b) Section 107(a) is amended by striking the phrase "not less than 4 of these voting" and inserting the phrase "not less than 5 of these voting" in its place.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
