

D. C. Law 2-110

"Condominium Act of 1976"

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 2-200, on first and second readings June 13, 1978 and June 27, 1978, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on July 17, 1978, this legislation was assigned Act No. 2-231, published in the August 11, 1978, edition of the D. C. Register and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c) (1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D. C. Law 2-110, effective September 22, 1978.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

September 22, 1978

To amend the Condominium Act of 1975 relating to the advertisement of condominiums.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Condominium Act of 1975 Amendment of 1978".

Sec. 2. Section 102(v) of the Condominium Act of 1975, effective March 29, 1977 (D.C. Law 1-89; D.C. Code, sec. 5-1202(v)), is amended by striking out the phrase "if such advertisement states that it does not constitute an offer of sale and that an offer may be made only in compliance with the condominium act of the state or territory in which the condominium is located".

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect as provided for acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
