
NOTICE

D.C. LAW 4-172

"Police Officer and Firefighter Cadet Programs  
Funding Authorization and Human Rights Act of  
1977 Amendment Act of 1982".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 4-421 on first and second readings, October 19, 1982 and November 16, 1982, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on December 8, 1982, this legislation was assigned Act No. 4-254, published in the December 31, 1982, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 29 page 5745). This act was originally transmitted to Congress on December 13, 1982, and resubmitted on January 6, 1983 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 4-172, effective March 9, 1983.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

DEC 08 1982

To authorize the appropriation of funds to implement and conduct training and education programs for District of Columbia public school students and other persons interested in becoming police officers with the Metropolitan Police Department or firefighters with the District of Columbia Fire Department, and to make a clarifying amendment to the Human Rights Act of 1977.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the "Police Officer and Firefighter Cadet Programs Funding Authorization and Human Rights Act of 1977 Amendment Act of 1982".

Sec. 2. (a) The Chief of the Metropolitan Police Department may establish a police officer cadet program for the purpose of instructing, training, and exposing interested persons, primarily young adults residing in the District of Columbia, to the operations of the Metropolitan Police Department and the duties, tasks, and responsibilities of serving as a police officer with the Metropolitan Police Department.

(b) The Chief of the District of Columbia Fire Department may establish a firefighter cadet program for the purpose of instructing, training, and exposing interested persons, primarily young adults residing in the District of Columbia, to the operations of the District of Columbia Fire Department and the duties, tasks, and responsibilities of

serving as a firefighter with the District of Columbia Fire Department.

(c) A person successfully completing the required training and service in a cadet program established pursuant to this section shall be accorded full preference for appointment as a member of the Metropolitan Police Department or of the District of Columbia Fire Department, if the person shall have met all other requirements pertaining to membership in the chosen department.

(d) There may be appropriated the funds necessary for the administration of this section.

Sec. 3. Section 20 of An Act To authorize certain programs and activities of the government of the District of Columbia, and for other purposes, approved October 26, 1973 (87 Stat. 508; D.C. Code sec. 31-2212) is amended by designating the current text as subsection "(a)" and adding at the end thereof the following new subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:

"(b) There may be appropriated the funds necessary for the administration of comprehensive programs, established in consultation with the Chief of the Metropolitan Police Department and the Chief of the District of Columbia Fire Department, to train and educate students in the public schools to become police officers or firefighter cadets, which funds shall be available for transfer to the Board of Education at the request of the Board, should the Board determine that it will conduct these programs in the public schools.

"(c) A student who is a resident of the District of Columbia and who successfully completes a curriculum established pursuant to this section shall be accorded a preference rating which shall be taken into consideration if the student applies for appointment to either the Metropolitan Police Department cadet program or the District of Columbia Fire Department cadet program."

Sec. 4. The Human Rights Act of 1977, effective December 13, 1977 (D.C. Law 2-38; D.C. Code, sec. 1-2501 et seq.) is amended as follows:


Sec. 5. The Board of Education may issue rules necessary for the implementation and operation of programs of education and training as may be established by the Board pursuant to section 3.



Sec. 7. This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233 (c)(1)).
