

D.C. LAW 5-93

"First Source Employment Agreement Act of 1984".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 5-341 on first and second readings, April 10, 1984 and April 30, 1984, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on May 9, 1984, this legislation was assigned Act No. 5-134, published in the May 25, 1984 edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 31 page 2545) and transmitted to Congress May 15, 1984 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 5-93, effective June 29, 1984.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

MAY 09 1984

To provide employment opportunities in entry-level positions in District of Columbia government-assisted projects for unemployed residents of the District of Columbia.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "First Source Employment Agreement Act of 1984".

Sec. 2. Definitions.

For the purposes of this act, the term:

(1) "Beneficiary" means the signator to a contract executed by the Mayor which involves any District of Columbia government funds, or funds which, in accordance with a federal grant or otherwise, the District of Columbia government administers, and which details the number and description of each entry-level job created by a government-assisted project for which the beneficiary is required to use the First Source Register.

(2) "Employment agreement" means the contract referred to in paragraph (1).

(3) "Entry-level job" means any nonmanagerial, nonprofessional, or nontechnical position.

(4) "First Source Register" means a listing of unemployed District residents.

(5) "Government-assisted project" means any project funded in whole or in part with District of Columbia funds, or funds which, in accordance with a federal grant or otherwise, the District of Columbia government administers, and on which the District of Columbia is signatory to any agreement of a contractual nature.

(6) "Unemployed District resident" means:

(A) any unemployed resident of the District of Columbia who does not receive unemployment compensation benefits pursuant to the District of Columbia Unemployment Compensation Act, approved August 28, 1935 (49 Stat. 956; D.C. Code, sec. 46-101 et seq.), and who lives within the boundaries of the Advisory Neighborhood Commission in which the government-assisted project is located;

(B) any unemployed resident of the District of Columbia who does not receive unemployment compensation benefits pursuant to the District of Columbia Unemployment Compensation Act, approved August 28, 1935 (49 Stat. 956; D.C. Code, sec. 46-101 et seq.); or

(C) any other unemployed resident of the District of Columbia.

Sec. 3. First Source Register Created.

(a) The Mayor shall compile and maintain a First Source Register consisting of the names of unemployed District residents.

(b) In compiling and maintaining the First Source Register the Mayor shall contact community organizations, Advisory Neighborhood Commissions, civic and citizen

associations, and project area committees for names of unemployed District residents.

Sec. 4. Employment Agreements Required.

(a) The Mayor shall include for every government-assisted project a requirement that the beneficiary enter into an employment agreement with the District of Columbia government which states that:

(1) the first source for finding employees to fill all entry-level jobs created by the government-assisted project will be the First Source Register; and

(2) the first source for finding employees to fill any vacancy occurring in an entry-level job covered by an employment agreement will be the First Source Register.

(b) In selecting unemployed District residents from the First Source Register for interviews for the entry-level jobs covered by each employment agreement, the Mayor shall:

(1) give first preference to unemployed District residents pursuant to section 2(a)(6)(A); and

(2) give second preference to unemployed District residents pursuant to section 2(a)(6)(B).

The Mayor shall submit a semiannual report to the Council of the District of Columbia on January 31st and July 31st of each year. The report shall include, for each preceding 6-month period:

(1) the number of government-assisted projects for which employment agreements were executed;

(2) the number of entry-level jobs covered by

each employment agreement;

(3) the number of unemployed District residents actually employed in government-assisted projects; and

(4) the number of names of employed District residents on the First Source Register.


Sec. 6. Rules.



The Mayor shall issue rules to carry out the purposes of this act not later than 60 days after the effective date of this act.

Sec. 7. Effective Date.

This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(1)).
